Volunteer requirements

The experience of volunteering can be truly gratifying: to serve a cause, practice one's ideals and Christian faith.

If you have 2 or more hours a fortnight to spare and want to do something rewarding, Care & Concern could be what you are looking for.

No special training or qualifications are required, just the desire to assist those with a need. You should be patient, punctual, nonjudgemental and respect the confidentiality of both the parish and the client.

Volunteer drivers and appointment setters are always required.

- Volunteer drivers require a reliable vehicle with comprehensive insurance and a current driver's licence
- Appointment setters are rostered to attend the office (a maximum of 2 hours per month) to receive requests for transport and allocate drivers.

Peer support is provided to all new volunteers and also through regular newsletters and bimonthly meetings.

Whilst no charge is made for the services – we do request a donation from clients for each trip to help offset vehicle running costs..

Care & Concern volunteers provide private transport for health related appointments for people of the local community:

- who cannot utilise public transport
- do not have access to family support or affordable alternatives

Things to know about Care & Concern

- Volunteer drivers supply both their time and vehicle to transport clients to their medical appointments
- Volunteer appointment setters staff the office to take calls for transport and allocate drivers.
- Clients should reside within the boundaries of the Burleigh Heads Catholic Parish
- Clients must be able to independently access and exit the vehicle and their appointment without assistance from the volunteer. Clients must be ACAT classified "low care" or equivalent
- Normally, the destinations are within the area bounded by—
 - Smith Street, Southport to the North
 - o Terranora Inlet to the South
 - Worongary Road and M1 Freeway to the West
 - The beach front defines the East
- Care & Concern is a transport service only.
- We do not take wheelchairs however, walking aids such as sticks and walking frames are acceptable
