SAINTS PETER AND PAUL, APOSTLES 29 June 2025

Year C/1

This Week's Readings: Acts 3:1-10; Gal 1:11-20; Jn 21:15-19 Next Week's Readings: Is 66:10-14; Gal 6:14-18; Lk 10:1-12, 17-20

We celebrate the great Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, the two towering figures who shaped the early Church. Though very different in background and

personality, both men were called, transformed, and sent by Christ to proclaim the Gospel to the world. They stand together as twin pillars of faith, courage, and mission.

Peter, the fisherman from Galilee, was chosen by Jesus to be the rock on which the Church would be built. His journey was not perfect. He misunderstood Jesus, faltered in faith, and even denied knowing Him. Yet Peter's deep love for the Lord, his repentance, and his bold leadership reminds us that God does not call the



qualified, but He qualifies the called. Peter teaches us the power of forgiveness, humility, and perseverance in following Christ.

Paul, once a fierce persecutor of Christians, encountered Christ on the road to Damascus and became the apostle to the Gentiles. His life was radically changed by grace, and he spent the rest of it tirelessly preaching the Gospel across the ancient world. His letters, full of passion and deep theology, continue to inspire and challenge us today.

For us modern-day disciples, the lives of Peter and Paul offer both comfort and challenge. Like Peter, we may feel unworthy or stumble in faith, but we are still called to lead, to love, and to serve. Like Paul, we may carry burdens of our past, but through God's grace we can be renewed and sent forth as messengers of hope.

In a world that often discourages faith, Saints Peter and Paul urge us to stand firm, to speak boldly, and to live joyfully in Christ. They remind us that the Church is built not on perfection, but on faith, trust, and mission.

May we, like Peter and Paul, become fearless witnesses, willing to give our lives, however ordinary—for the extraordinary mission of the Gospel.


