Thank you once more for your welcome to me over these weeks.

Our NAIDOC week concludes this Sunday. Archbishop Coleridge last weekend in St

Stephen's Cathedral reflected the ongoing journey towards reconciliation and said, "We speak about closing the gap. So we recognise that there is a gap between Indigenous and non-Indigenous Australians. And we also recognise that there is a need to close the gap, and yet the gap grows wider... It



may seem hopeless, but it isn't." Archbishop Coleridge encouraged Catholics in the Archdiocese to continue the reconciliation journey with hope.

Our parishes in the Archdiocese have a common direction in the future through last year's Synod decisions. When the Synod of the Archdiocese of Brisbane was convened in 2024 to action the national Plenary Council decrees, one of the specific areas was "Reconciliation: Healing Wounds, Receiving Gifts".

Joe Higgins of The Catholic Leader covered the event and wrote:

'This decree had three actions, which were all endorsed by clear majorities... The first action was about an archdiocesan plan to provide opportunities for those in parishes, communities and agencies to deepen their knowledge of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples, histories, cultures and spiritualities.

The second action was about the archdiocese creating and distributing resources for parishes, communities and agencies to meaningfully include aspects of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander cultures, traditions, spiritualities, ritual and symbol in prayers and liturgies.

The third action was about developing culturally specific learning and formation opportunities for Aboriginal peoples and Torres Strait Islander peoples by the archdiocese.'

In Archdiocesan Ministries, we have a **Reconciliation Action Plan (RAP) Manager** - Joni McCourt, and a **Murri Ministry Coordinator** - Ravina Waldren. Murri Ministry was formed in 1993 after consultation with Catholic Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples. In July this year, Murri Ministry moved from Centacare to Archdiocesan Ministries. The RAP Program and Murri Ministry Team work together on many initiatives, including the actions of the Brisbane Synod pertaining to **'Reconciliation: Healing Wounds, Receiving Gifts'**.

Each Parish is invited to access the RAP process. **Each Parish** is invited to contact their local First Nations Peoples through contact with Rayina Waldren.

This weekend's Gospel passage from Luke, is about Jesus telling a parable of a Good Samaritan. Inspired by this parable, like the survivor, the Samaritan and the innkeeper, and in our love for God, may our parishes build partnerships with our Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander neighbours, to love each other, and to love our common home, the earth.
