#### THE LORD'S PRAYER

We are more familiar with the Gospel of Matthew's version of the Lord's Prayer (Our Father) in our daily prayer, in the rosary, and in the Mass.

Today in the Gospel of Luke, we hear the shorter version. As we read it, we are

invited to compare it to the prayer we know off by heart. We ask ourselves how it is different and how it is similar.

In 1973, Melbourne hosted the International Eucharistic Congress. An Aboriginal version of the Lord's Prayer was sung. It has been translated over the years into several First Nations' languages. A link to the prayer can be found at

The words of the **Aboriginal Our Father** are:

You are our Father, you live in heaven, we talk to you. Father you are good. (x2)

We believe your word, Father, We are your children, give us bread today. (x2)

We have done wrong, we are sorry, teach us, Father, all about your Word. (x2)

Others have done wrong to us, And we are sorry for them, Father, today. (x2)

Stop us from doing wrong, Father, save us all from the evil one. (x2)

You are our Father, you live in heaven, We talk to you. Father you are good. (x2)

#### **RECONCILIATION ACTION PLANS (RAPS)**

Some Parishes in the Archdiocese already have Reconciliation Action Plans (RAPS), whereas Brisbane Catholic Education (BCE) do have RAPS in their schools and a history of many years of engagement with First Nations Peoples. As Parishes develop their own RAPS, they can draw upon First Nations connections with BCE and Centacare and the St Vincent de Paul Society.

According to the Brisbane Catholic Education **2024** figures, the number of First Nations students at BCE schools and Colleges on the **Gold Coast** is:

78 Burleigh Heads; 15 Coolangatta Tugun; 107 Coomera; 10 Nerang; 14 Runaway Bay; 32 Southport and 48 Surfers Paradise.

Some years ago, I was in one of the pilot parishes for Reconciliation Action Plans. It was a great experience and I recommend each parish having one. It offers clarity and direction.

Of course, a parish RAP is not identical to a Catholic School RAP.

Archbishop Mark Coleridge is the designated 'champion' for Archdiocesan RAPS.

We can hear more about it on our parish First Nations Raising Awareness evening on Tuesday, 5<sup>th</sup> August.
