SECOND SUNDAY IN LENT 25 February 2024

Year B/2

This Week's Readings: Gen 22:1-2, 9-13, 15-18; Rom 8:31-34; Mk 9:2-10 Next Week's Readings: Ex 20:1-17; 1 Cor 1:22-25; Jn 2:13-25

MOUNTAIN

After six days Jesus took Peter, James, and John with him and led them up a high <u>mountain</u>, where they were all alone. There he was transfigured before them (Mark 9:2).

Scripture is rich with magnificent scenes and views of nature - from rushing rivers (Ez. 43:2) to still waters (Ps. 23:2); trees (Mt.7:17), vineyards (Is. 5:7), lush gardens (Ps. 65:12), caves (Gn. 23:17), valleys, thunder, rain, and lightning and many others. All of them tell a story within the narrative of the scripture. But mountaintops occupy a unique place in the Judaic-Christian tradition and



biblical narratives as the place of God-Encounter.

Mountains and hilltops are mentioned quite a lot in the bible. Old Testament people believed that worshipping God on the tops of mountains brought one closer to God who dwells in the heavens above. As a result, the Old Testament is filled with high places of God encounter where altars being built to worship God. For example, God reveals himself to Abraham on a mountain - 'Mt. Moriah' as Abraham demonstrates his willingness to sacrifice his one and only son Isaac (Gen. 22: 1-14). God reveals redemptive plans to Moses on Mount Horeb (Ex. 3:1) and gives Ten Commandments on Mt. Sinai (Ex 19:25). Prophet Elijah encounters God at Mt. Carmel and wins over the prophets of Baal (1 Kg 18:20).

Throughout the public ministry the life and ministry of Jesus was deeply associated with mountains. Jesus conquered the third temptation by Satan at the peak of a mountain (Mt 4:8); gave his great sermon on a mountain (Mt 5:1); often retired to the mountains with his disciples for prayer (Jn 6:15); transfigured on Mt. Tabor (Lk 9:28), prays at Mt. Olives before his passion (Lk 22:39) and sacrificed life at Mt. Calvary. Finally, the commissioning of apostles and ascension into heaven also takes place on a mountain (Mt 28:16).

One of the most significant mountain scenes in the Gospels is the Transfiguration of Jesus on Mt. Tabor. Jesus appears with Moses and Elijah, who themselves encountered God on the mountaintop in the Old Testament. Moments of transfiguration at Mount Tabor were moments of God-encounter for Jesus' disciples.

Lenten season with its observance offers lot of mountaintop trans-figurative moments of God- encounter. Amen.






Make me hear rejoicing and **gladness**, that the bones you have crushed **may revive**. From my sins turn away your **face** and blot out **all my guilt**.


