

TEMPLE "WE ARE THE TEMPLE OF THE LIVING GOD"



Don't you realize that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit......

We are in the third Sunday of Lent, Let us purify our body, the dwelling place of God, who is mighty and creator of the world. Let us purify ourselves by praying, fasting and repenting from all our sins.

In today's first reading we hear about the ten commandments of God. God is trying to tell them that a person does not become really free when he comes out of slavery, but he/she becomes really free only when he/she follow the commandments of God. That's why God gave them the commandments.

The second reading is taken from first letter to the Corinthians Paul highlights the cross and the proclamation of Christ crucified which are the core of Paul's preaching. To the Greek or Roman thinker, God couldn't be harmed by humans, let alone be executed as the worst of criminals! God did not choose to save people by the sort of powerful act that many Jews wanted. He did not choose to impress people by his great wisdom, as people from other nations wanted. Instead, He sent His only begotten Son, Jesus, to die on the cross. God's ways are beyond our comprehension and God had always used the unexpected person to achieve his goals so that it is clear He has done it not human wisdom or skills. To those who are called by God, the cross it not absurd. We can see that the cross is not foolishness at all, but is instead the power and wisdom of God.

It is powerful because it has power to save. It is wise because Christ's death on the cross says more clear than anything else that God's love for us has no bounds.

We hear plenty about Jesus being kind and compassionate towards people. But today's gospel presents to us an angry and outrageous Jesus who overturns the tables of the money exchange and chases away those people who had made His Father's house a robbers den, a house of prayer into a market place. He did this because those people failed to realize the sanctity of the place and respect the divinity that is present in the temple. This teaches us an important lesson, Church is a meeting place with God hence it must be for us a place where we experience God. We cannot behave as we want but as it is expected of us.

Let us repent, cleanse ourselves - a temple of God- desecrated by our unholy activities. Let us return to Christ for mercy and compassion and become worthy temple for God to live in.

The commandments help us not to commit sin. So let us obey the commandments of God in order to grow in our life as the Lord wants.

"Thus says the Lord, if you love me you will obey my commandments."


