Year B/2

This Week's Readings: Amos 7:12-15; Eph 1:3-14; Mk 6:7-13

Next Week's Readings: Jer 23:1-6; Eph 2:13-18; Mk 6:30-34

“For the LORD is the great God, the great King above all gods. In his hand are the depths of the earth, and the mountain peaks belong to him. The sea is his, for he made it, and his hands formed the dry land. Come, let us bow down in worship, let us kneel before the LORD our Maker; for he is our God and we are the people of his pasture, the flock under his care.” – Psalm 95:3-7

This Psalm begins with a call to worship. It expects a celebration, one that includes music with a tone of joy, thanksgiving and praise. We can be wholeheartedly enthusiastic about praising God. A Sea Sunday service can be as celebratory as any other Sunday. Yes, it is about seafarers, but the focus is God, the Rock of our salvation, who inspires our worship.

“For the LORD is the great God, the great King above all gods. In his hands are the depths of the earth, and the mountain peaks belong to him. The sea is his, for he made it, and his hands formed the dry land.” – Psalm 95:3-5

Here we have the reason for worship. We are told who God is and what he has made. It is not surprising that something of God himself can be seen in His creation. The psalmist describes places that to him were inaccessible, such as the top of a mountain, down beneath the earth and the sea. Sure, the psalm writer cannot simply go to such places, but to God they are fully accessible, for they are his as he made them. The earth is not only made by God; it is held by God in His hand. He creates and sustains. The wonders which we behold remain because God wills it so.

“Come, let us bow down in worship, let us kneel before the LORD our Maker.” – Psalm 95:6

This verse tells us about the attitude of worship. The descriptions are of bodily postures, kneeling and bowing. They are postures of humility and lowliness in us and the worship and greatness of God. We come to God not only with physical signs of humility but with humble hearts. What else can we do before such a great God than take the lowest of places? But we should not mistake this for a fearful audience with a distant God. There is fellowship here between God and the worshipper, who knows that God comes close to those who come close to Him.

“For he is our God and we are the people of his pasture, the flock under his care.” – Psalm 95:7

Here, we find confirmation of the intimacy suggested above. God’s worshippers are like a flock of sheep with their shepherd. This well-known Biblical picture has become a way of understanding the close bond between God and those who follow Him.

We go out of the house. We set off walking, cycling, driving, or maybe we go by bus or train.

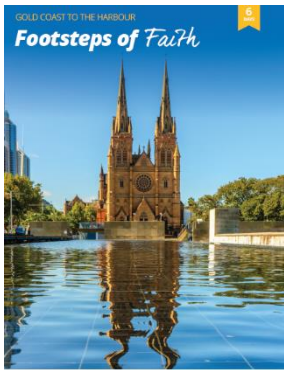
- We trust our physical abilities through our arms, legs, eyes etc.

You are a caver, exploring underground caverns. The caves you enter belong to God. You are a sailor, heading onto the sea. The sea on which you sail belongs to God. It is his and he made it.
